TWAS will be accepting applications for the 2021 session of research grants from 27 January 2021 to 14 April 2021

The **World Academy of Sciences (TWAS)** – for the advancement of science in developing countries, is an international science academy, founded in 1983 in Trieste, Italy, under the leadership of the late Nobel laureate Abdus Salam of Pakistan. In 1991, the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) assumed responsibility for administering TWAS by an agreement signed by TWAS and UNESCO.

The current call is for two kinds of grants, available to **scientists from science and technology lagging countries** that currently hold a minimum qualification of a PhD degree.

TWAS Research Grants Programme in Basic Sciences (Groups & Individuals)

Under this scheme, grants are awarded to research projects in Biology, Chemistry, Mathematics and Physics carried out by **research units (Groups)** and **individual scientists (Individuals)** in the S&T-lagging countries identified by TWAS, full list available on the TWAS website.

The age limit may vary slightly between the two grants.
